Foreword

RHA Training has adapted to the ever-changing landscape we all find ourselves in. We created our online training courses to continue meeting the needs of our customers during successive lockdowns. With social distancing restrictions lifting we have seen a steady return to classroom and in cab courses. Alongside this, still maintaining our range of online courses, to keep supporting those members and customers learning remotely.

Ongoing discussion with relevant stakeholders (DVSA, JAUPT and the OTC) means regular reviews guidance by updating our portfolio of face to face and online learning. In 2021 we welcomed over 2000 people onto online courses and over 1000 face-to-face events in COVID Safe venues.

We're pleased that, subject to the continued easing of restrictions, RHA Training will continue our face-to-face training courses including Transport Manager CPC courses which are always in high demand. Our number one priority is to make sure our delegates and staff remain safe during courses.

The RHA introduced coach membership early in 2021, as a result RHA Training are introducing new services supporting the coach sector in this year. We will be offering initial Passenger Transport Manager CPC along with a 2-day Passenger Transport CPC Refresher course.


