



## Job Description – LGV C+E Driver

### Job Purpose:

- Drive mobile eye examination unit between locations in the UK and Eire
- Set up and assemble/disassemble mobile examination trailer
- Support coordination operations between venues and customer

### Key responsibilities and duties:

- To ensure the vehicle and trailer is kept in a roadworthy and compliant condition at all times
- Ensure arrival at the allocated location in a timely manner with adequate time to set up and assemble the mobile examination unit
- Ensure the tractor unit and trailer is kept in clean condition at all times, both inside and out
- Ensure mobile generators have sufficient fuel
- To be smart and presentable at all times
- Regular Nights out will be required where hotel accommodation will be provided
- Occasional weekend work will be required

### Key skills and attributes:

- This is a public facing position so you must be able to communicate confidently with the public
- Strong communication skills essential both written and verbal
- Be punctual and reliable
- Have excellent time management skills
- You must have a “can do” attitude and approach to work
- You need to be resourceful and be able to work on your own initiative
- You will be part of a two person team so a team work is essential
- You must have strong organisational skills with attention to detail
- You must have a very good understanding of both EU Drivers Hours and WTD legislation

### Key requirements:

- Must hold a valid UK C+E vocational driving licence

- Must hold a valid up to date DQC
- Must have a Digital tachograph card
- Must hold a valid Passport
- Be prepared to have a DBS check
- Be prepared to spend 4-5 nights out per week when required
- Has had experience in conducting on site Risk Assessments (desirable)
- Has had basic First Aid training (desirable)
- Regular DCPC training will be provided FOC
